
Tau Chapter Hosts Eastern Division Conference 2006 Rush Nets 30 New Brothers

The past semester went well for Delta Tau Delta at Penn State. Following the Fall 2006 rush period, the Chapter once again nearly doubled in size! There were 30 new initiates this year- which was very respectable- bringing the Chapter membership to over 80 brothers for the first time in over 10 years. The quality of these young men (along with the rest of our Brotherhood) was shown with another strong performance in academics- the Chapter's fall GPA was a 3.12- once again exceeding the All-Men's and All-Fraternity average at Penn State.

Tau Chapter recently marked the completion of their first year paired with Delta

Zeta sorority for Dance Marathon. After a rocky start, the two organizations quickly bonded and found common ground in raising money for their two sponsor families, the Klines and the Mosers. 



Please note that everything in a large, old fraternity house costs much more than it would for a normal residence. The cost of improvements far exceeds our campaign receipts to date. The balance has been financed from chapter rent and a

mortgage through the DTD Educational Foundation. Continued success will allow us to complete remaining projects, and reduce or eliminate the mortgage. **Thank you for your past and future support!** 

The remaining major renovation projects include the Chapter Room, Main Hall, Dining Room, Kitchen and Social Room (basement). A new patio off the Dining Room is also planned. The total cost of these remaining projects may approach \$500,000 and will serve alumni and many future generations of Tau Delts.
